Translation lists were prepared for each of the two main hand-books of *The Virtues Project*. The Virtues Project

The Virtues Project began in Canada in 1991. The founders wanted to do something to counter a growing trend of violence in high schools and colleges in North America. They saw a need for a multicultural resource that would help young people find their inner strength and goodness. After much study of the worlds' wisdom traditions, virtues were identified as a common theme. The Educators Guide and its supporting resources were written, tailored to the needs of teachers and students, and many other resources have since emerged.

The Virtues Project is an independent NGO - not affiliated with any government, corporate, educational, or religious organization. The vision of *The Virtues Project* is to serve humanity by supporting the ethical and spiritual development of people of all cultures, by helping us remember who we really are and to live by our highest values. Ongoing inspirational programs, and character education materials, support communities across the world to implement the programme.

The Virtues Project was honoured as a model programme for families at the World Conference of Cities, Local Government & Private Sector Partners on Families, in association with the United Nations Secretariat, in the International Year of the Family, and is being applied in over 87 countries.
